Cowboy Lever Action (CLA) and Pistol Cartridge Cowboy Lever Action (PCCLA) 40 round Silhouette Matches for 2016

Competition Dates: April 16, May 21, June 18, July 16, Aug. 20, Sept. 24, & Oct. 15, 2016

Range Location: 10801 South 134th Street, Bennet, NE 68317 (One-half mile South of Nebraska Hwy #2 on South 134th street) (Matches will be held on Range #4)

Competition is open to the public

Entry fee \$8.00 for each 40 round match

Awards: Honors only. Ten-in-a-row pins and match winner pins will be awarded. All ties for match winner will be broken by shoot-offs as set forth in the NRA rule book.

Times: All times listed pertaining to matches are approximate.

Entries: Entries for CLA will be accepted at approximately 8:30 a.m. and will close at approximately 9:15 a.m. the date of each shoot. No advance entries will be taken.

Firing: Practice will be allowed the day of each shoot, but only AFTER competitors have completed their registration materials, been squaded, received their score cards, and placed their names on the score board. Practice for CLA will take place from approximately 8:30 a.m. until 9:15 a.m. The CLA match will begin at approximately 9:30 a.m. A "make your own sandwich" lunch will follow the CLA match. Following the short lunch break, sign-up and practice for the pistol cartridge match will begin at 12:30 p.m. with the intention of the match beginning at 1:15 p.m.

Rules: NRA Cowboy Lever Action Silhouette Rules will govern each shoot. Additionally, this program will govern entry times, practice times, and match times. Other locally produced information will be secondary to this program.

Match courses of 40 shots at the appropriate ranges for CLA and PCCLA will consist of: Ten shots each at Chickens, Pigs, Turkeys and Rams.

Targets used will be the standard NRA targets appropriate for CLA and PCCLA.

Classification will be based upon the latest NRA rules.

General Information: NRA Classification books for 2016 will be required of ALL shooters, so bring yours with you, or purchase one at the matches. Attendance at the safety briefing before the matches is mandatory.
