## New Ground Baffle on Rifle Range 2 – PLEASE READ

On July 26<sup>th</sup>, Scout Jacob Klein completed an Eagle Scout Project was completed on Range 2. This is a ground baffle that is removable by lane to allow prone shooting if needed (simply remove the 2 x 6 in your lanes if needed and then replace them before you leave). The purpose of this is to prevent any issues with ground skips. **The baffle is not to hang or place targets on and there will be consequences for anyone that does this.** Do not shoot the baffle or use it for targets or to place swingers in front of. It is a safety improvement for additional bullet retention that is not to be shot on purpose or to be used for a backstop for short range shooting on Range 2. This range remains a 100-yard Range and no other distances are allowed to be shot on Range 2 during normal shooting by members. Thank you for helping to keep our ranges safe and undamaged.

- Keep ALL firearms in your vehicle until after the safety briefing and you are instructed to bring them to the firing line.
- No illegal firearms are allowed.
- At centerfire-friendly ranges, rifle cartridges are limited to 8mm (rifle) or .45 caliber (pistol and pistol caliber carbines).

## Details:

We will shoot at 25 meters. Bring a .22 rimfire rifle and some spare mags and gain valuable marksmanship skills without using up your expensive center fire ammo. You will want about 400 - 500 rounds. GI web sling highly recommended. Centerfire is welcome, so if you have a new high-power rifle or new mags you want to test drive at 25-meters, that is OK too. While it is expensive, there is no better way to learn if you can depend on your equipment than putting 400 - 500 rounds through it in.

- No Tracer, AP, or incendiary ammo allowed (fire hazard, hard on steel targets). Attracts a magnet is OK.
- Please leave your rifles in the car until asked to bring them to the firing line.
- Please, no handguns (concealed or open) on the firing line.
- Bring layered clothing, raingear, a windbreaker, and lightweight gloves, eye protection, and hearing protection. Dress for the weather and bring raingear if forecasted.
- Bring a lunch, snacks, and plenty of water. A shooting jacket will be extremely helpful, especially if shooting a high-power rifle, and a shooting mat may make prone and sitting positions more comfortable.
- No alcohol permitted.

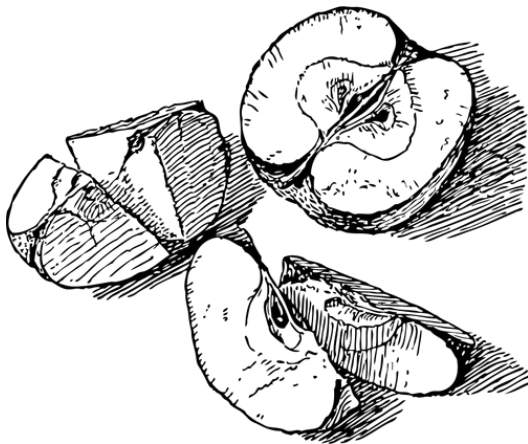
