Will you accept the challenge?

The .22 Challenge Fun Match, that is!

Coming soon to the Ike's will be a new—and hopefully fun—.22 rimfire match. Well, not so much of a "match" as a fun competitive shoot. In short, the rules are simple: engage 8 swinging targets, each one smaller than the last, with 10 rounds. Miss one and you keep trying until you either hit it or run out of your initial 10 rounds.

Each target is worth an increasing point value; add up your points, and that's your score for that segment of the match. If time allows, each shooter will get up to 3 opportunities to engage the targets for a total of 30 shots.

Everyone will shoot against like firearms. Lever action with open sights will shoot against lever actions with open sights; benchrest guns against benchrest guns and so on. Open sighted and small magnification scope guns will shoot from the 25-yard line. Most all others will shoot from the 50-yard line, all on range 1.

So, dust off your grandpa's old squirrel rifle or bring your new fangled super-shooter with a 50X scope, it doesn't matter. Win or lose, it's going to be a blast.

Lincoln Ikes Chapter Leadership Elections Coming Soon

It is just about time for board elections! Every year, we have four (4) of our board of directors' positions come up for election or re-election to a three-year term. We have four members that would like to be considered for your vote. The requirements and expectations of our board of directors' members are as follows:

QUALIFICATIONS FOR THOSE TO BE ELECTED TO THE BOARD OF DIRECTORS:

- Must be an active advocate and paid current year member
- Must be a current member for at least the last two consecutive years (i.e. Cannot run for board until completing at least two (2) full years as a member.)
- Expected to attend monthly board of directors' meetings, which are generally held the second Tuesday of each month in our clubhouse beginning 7:15 p.m.

QUALITIES TO LOOK FOR IN A BOARD OF DIRECTOR MEMBER:

- A current member who is an active and vibrant participant of our Lincoln Izaak Walton League and with the values our organization holds
- Someone with a sense of vision to help with the betterment of our Lincoln Ikes as a whole
- Someone with creativity and energy, and willing to give of their talents for our Lincoln Ikes
- A willingness to listen to other member's viewpoints, collaborate and compromise
- The ability and the desire to work with other Board members and current members as a team for the progress of our Lincoln Ikes, keeping safety as the upmost priority

OTHER BOARD OF DIRECTORS INFORMATION

- The property, affairs, activities, and concerns of the Lincoln Chapter shall be vested in a Board of Directors consisting of thirteen (13) Directors.
- The new members of the Board shall assume the performance of their duties, on September 1st of each year, and shall continue in office until their successors shall be duly elected and qualified.
- New members shall, however, attend the August Board meeting to adequately provide for a smooth transition, and to vote for the newly elected officers for the following year.
- New members elected in July of each year may vote only for new officers during the August board meeting.
- Outgoing members of the board shall retain full voting rights until September 1st except for voting on new officers.
- Special meetings of the board of directors may be called by, or at the request of, the president or any two directors.
- <u>Items that are covered during the monthly meetings: Guest Introductions/Presentations, approval of previous meeting's minutes from the secretary, Treasurer's Report, Membership Report, Manager's Reports, Groundskeeper Reports, Committee Reports (Rifle/Pistol Committee Meeting, Archery Committee, Safety & Rules Committee, and Trap Committee), Match Directors Reports, New Business, and Unfinished/Tabled Business.</u>

Current members can email or send their ballots by mail, or wait and hand them in when attending the annual all-members meeting and dinner in the Lincoln Ikes clubhouse on Saturday, July 20th at 12:00 noon. (ONE BALLOT PER REGULAR, STUDENT AND LIFE MEMBER; TWO BALLOTS FOR FAMILY MEMBERSHIPS.) But, before you submit your ballot and decide on your vote, be sure to review the essays each of the candidates have sent in. It is important to know more about who our leaders are and what experiences and skills they bring to the jobs they do for Lincoln Ikes. We thank all of those that have served, are running for re-election and any new candidates! Please see the June and July newsletter for the ballots and cast your vote then.

Stocking of Fishing Pond has Started

The work on the Ikes fishing pond has been completed with some dirt removal completed along with a nice fishing deck construction. This spring, we have received some nice rains and the water level has increased some at least to a point that we feel confident that it was time to start restocking fish into the pond. On May 9th, Rob Hofpar from Nebraska Lake Management located near Valparaiso delivered 500, 2-to-4-inch yearling bluegill (see attached photos). Once Rob learned that the pond was a kid fishing pond he cut the cost of the bluegill in half. Hopefully, we continue to get more rain with the plans to have Mr. Hofpar stock largemouth bass, channel catfish and grass carp in July.



Lincoln Ikes Host Three Eastern Cornhusker Conference Trap Shoots

The lkes trap range was the site of three Junior/Senior High trap shoots. On March 16th there was 155 Juniors and 284, April 6th had similar numbers with 165 Juniors and 283 Senior. On April 27th the Ikes hosted the All-Conference Junior High shoot with approximately 340 junior high shooters from across the conference. Special thanks to all the coaches and parents that assisted during these shoots to make them run smoothly. An additional thanks to the Southside 4H group that installed a new latch system to all the trap lids that made the operation of opening and securing them much easier. The spring practices and shoots can not happen without lots of help keeping the range clean and operating.

Voting Information

Ballot used to cast your vote is the same regardless of how you submit it. The goal of the board is to provide every member with the opportunity to vote. To that end, the board has approved the following three methods:

1. Electronic Ballot

Complete the member information section of the ballot. Then, enter your vote for the candidate(s) of your choice. When your ballot is complete, forward your ballot to: <u>ikes.lincoln@gmail.com</u>. A confirmation email will be sent back to you confirming that we received it.

2. Paper Ballot by Mail

Complete the member information section of the ballot. Then, enter your vote for the candidate(s) of your choice. Mail your completed ballot to: Election Committee

3. Paper Ballot in Person

Members who wish to attend the Annual Meeting, which we strongly encourage, can cast their ballot in person. You will be given a ballot to cast your vote for board seats and will be required to complete the member information section of the ballot, then select your vote for the candidate(s) of your choice.

The election committee will be the only people that will view your ballot. The election committee will check all ballots against the current membership roster.

Your vote will remain secret.

The election committee will only use it to check against the current membership roster to make sure that you only vote once. After the election results have been approved, all ballots will be destroyed and all emails deleted.

Ballot Submission Deadline

Walk-in ballots must be received by the start of the annual board meeting. Electronic and Mail in ballots must be received no later than:

12:00 noon, July 20, 2024
