2023 Hunter Sight-In Days

We will be hosting our three annual Hunter Sight-In Days, which are open to the public. These will be held on Sundays, October 29^{th} and November 5^{th} . The hours for this annual community event are 9:00 a.m. -3:00 p.m. There are many areas that need to be filled to ensure that we can offer these days for all. The hours we're needing volunteers for each of these days is approximately 8:00 a.m. until the ranges are cleaned up (about 3:30/4:00 p.m). We would love to have plenty of volunteers so the shifts can be shorter for all. Here are some of the areas that we need to fill for each day:

- Early morning set-up,
- Gate Information Volunteer,
- Rifle Safety Inspectors (with tools to inspect the firearms prior to use on the range to
 ensure all screws are tight, and that they have the right ammunition for their
 firearm),
- Ranges 1, 2 and 4 Sight-In Helpers/Guides, and
- Tear down at the end of the day.

Volunteers will need to bring eye and ear protection, rifle rests (if they have any), and spotting scopes or good binoculars. We are also looking for some great volunteers willing to help feed our busy helpers. Items we are looking for are:

- Early morning donuts or rolls
- Soup or easy meals at lunchtime
- Cookies or small desserts
- Individual Chip Bags
- Bottled water (the coffee, cups, plates, paper towels, napkins, and silverware are already taken care of.)



- · Any other questions that you might have about trapshooting and/or our trap range


