
Ikes Kitchen Open for Upcoming Events

2023 Membership Renewals & Gate Card Activation

Thank you to all who already renewed your 2023 memberships. For those who would like to renew, you have a couple options:

- a) mail in your renewal application and payment
- b) renew your 2023 membership online by going to our website at www.lincolnikes.com, then click "Member Login", which is on the green ribbon just underneath the large photo up top
- c) call our office during the regular work week, Monday thru Friday, from 8:00 a.m. -5:00 p.m.

If you have not renewed, your gate card has been deactivated. Reactivation of your gate card may take up to a week so please plan accordingly. Your 2023 range cards are mailed out after we process your renewal applications and payments. If you have any questions regarding your renewal, please contact Natalie. Thank you!

Please note that the membership dues for 2023 are as follows for REGULAR members (family, student, and life members, please see your renewal notices for your membership dues total or call our office for these different amounts): \$160 for rifle & pistol range access, \$160 for trap range access, or \$200 for all ranges (rifle/pistol and trap). As always, our memberships run for the full 2023 calendar year (January 1st - December 31st), *starting when you renew*.



2023 SUMMER TRAP LEAGUE

Teams can submit their rosters by either email or USPS (no team meeting). Sponsor fees can be paid at that time or the first night of league. Please provide me your team's name two weeks prior to the first night of league. The first night of shooting is scheduled to begin on May 4th and the Summer League is schedule to end on August 10th, thus a 15-week season (rain out makeup date on August 17th if needed). The Fall League is scheduled to run from August 24th through October 12th, thus a season of 8 weeks. Currently the sponsor fees will remain at \$85 per team for the Summer League and \$40 for the Fall League as well as the cost per round of \$8. Teams that are entirely youth shooters will be charged \$50 and \$25 respectively.

During the Summer Trap League season, shooting typically starts at 6:30 p.m. and ends around 9:00-9:30 p.m. on Thursday nights. The team that shoots at 6:30 p.m. one week will shoot at 7:00 p.m. the next week. Only the team members on the roster are allowed to shoot. Scores the first two weeks of the Summer League along with team's shooting ability in the past will be used to classify. (AAA, AA, A, B, etc.) The first round will be from the 16-yard line and based on the team score, a handicap yardage will be assigned. Teams will be assigned on who they are competing against which will change every week.

One point will be assigned for the 16-yard, handicap and overall scores for a potential total of 3 points. All ties will split the point - giving both teams ½ the point. Team members need to have a minimum of one round of 16-yard targets and one round of handicaps during the first two weeks of qualifications. The Fall League will use the Lewis system to establish points with teams shooting at the same time each week

Lincoln Ikes 2023 YOUTH

Summer Trap League

SEASON INFORMATION:

Competition will consist of one round of 16-yard and one round of handicap from a predetermined yard-line.

This year, the youth trap league will run as follows:

Week 1 (May 15)

25 from the 16-yard line, 25 from the 18-yard line

Week 2 (May 22)

25 from the 16-yard line, 25 from the 18-yard line

Week 3 (June 5)

25 from the 16-yard line, 25 from the 20-yard line

Week 4 (June 12)

25 from the 16-yard line, 25 from the 20-yard line

Week 5 (June 19) 25 from the 16-yard line, 25 from the 23-yard line

June 19th is our "Family Fun Night" when any family member may shoot the last 13 of the 25 rocks at 16 yards for a combined family score. This is not required but encouraged. If a family member does participate, a bonus of 3 rocks will be added to the combined score of the youth shooter and the family member's 16-yard score.

Week 6 (June 26) 25 from the 16-yard line, 25 from the 23-yard line

If you miss a week, handicaps will be shot from the yard line scheduled for that current week. (For example, if you miss Week 2 and come back to shoot on Week 3, you will shoot all of your handicaps from that day's yard-line which would be 20-yard line.) You can do make-up shooting if you miss a week. Other than Week 5, there will be no shooting ahead.

SHOOTING DATES: Monday Evenings; May 15, 22 and June 5, 12, 19, 26

SHOOTING TIME: 6:00 p.m.

COST: \$72 for the season

(2 rounds of 25 targets per night: 6 nights x \$12 per night = \$72)

REGISTRATION: A registration form will be completed by the youth shooter

the first night he/she shoots.

All fees for the season are due by May 22nd – no exceptions.



REGISTRATION:

A small registration form will need to be completed prior to shooting. The form will request basic information (name, address, email, phone, parent's phone) in order to communicate weekly scores and keep families up to date on summer league information including the July banquet.

PARENT SUPERVISION & VOLUNTEERS NEEDED:

We will rely on parents to help as scorers and loaders, so please stick around and help throughout the evening. Especially those with young shooters, we highly encourage parents to stay and help/supervise their children. This isn't an activity where children are dropped off and left unsupervised. In past years, we are generally done by around 8:00 pm, so it's a pretty quick night.

INCLEMENT WEATHER:

We will generally have our league nights unless we have severe weather which would include thunderstorms. An update of any changes or cancelations will be posted to our Facebook page, **Lincoln Ike's Trap**, by **4:00 p.m.** on that Monday League night. Please like this page and follow it for any updates or notices.


