Weather / Range Conditions Heads-Up

During the winter months, we try to get the parking lot and the roads leading up to Rifle/ Pistol Ranges 1, 2 and 3 plowed as soon as possible. However, when we get a lot of snow or precipitation, all the traps and the cemented areas around the rifle and pistol benches/firing lines can be buried in snow and/or ice. With that in mind, we want all our members to be aware of the following, if you plan on shooting out here after inclement weather:

IF YOU ARE A CURRENT RIFLE/PISTOL MEMBER:

1. You may need to scoop/clear your area first.

2. DO NOT GO OFF ANY TRAILS THAT HAVE NOT ALREADY BEEN PLOWED. We cannot guarantee that someone will be out here to help at certain times. **IF YOU ARE A CURRENT TRAP MEMBER:**

1. The area around the traps and the fan may not be cleared.

2. The locks will most likely be frozen. You can hold them in your hands for a while to warm them up if needed. The traphouses may be covered as well to protect the inside of each of the traphouses from getting any snow inside. These can be taken off them, but then they need to have them put back on as they were before leaving.

Make sure you warm up the machines PRIOR to arming and starting to throw the rocks.
You will have to clear any snow away from the machine and pump PRIOR to running it.

With the wind that brings in snow, sometimes snow can get inside the traps. We welcome any volunteers who are willing to come clear these areas during these weather conditions. If you are able and interested, please contact the managers.

2023 Trap Range Activities

Trap range activities will be getting very active starting the first week of February with six school teams, Pius, Southwest, Southeast, Pound, Palmyra, and Sterling, using all the ranges for practices. Most of the practices run from 3:30 to 6:30 on Monday through Friday with some also utilizing some of the traps on Saturday and Sunday.

The Lincoln Ikes trap ranges will be the host site for 3 Eastern Cornhusker Trapshooting Conference meets on March 11^{th} , April 1^{st} , and April 22^{nd} . If any member that would like to come out and help me run the shoots it would be greatly appreciated.

This year the Ikes will have five ATA shoots with Jeff Krinke organizing these events. Dates for these shoots are May 6th, June 17th (Cole Anderson Shoot), July 4th, Oct. 1st and Oct. 14th. If you have never shot one of these matches it is easy to join the ATA and it is lots of fun. There are also other ATA shoots that you can attend across the state.

We will again host the Youth Trapshooting event for the Cornhusker State Games on July 22^{nd} with generally around 300 shooters attending. Again, I am always looking for help running this shoot.

Lastly, the Summer Trap league is scheduled to start on May 4^{th} . There will be additional information on this in the next newsletter.

While the trap houses maybe covered, they are still open for practice when the weather is nice.

Project Healing Waters Fly Fishing—Nebraska

If you read last month's Outdoor America, you may have seen Project Healing Waters Fly Fishing (PHWFF) mentioned briefly in the article "America's Veterans Find Healing in Outdoor Adventure." Nebraska currently has three PHWFF programs located in Omaha, Lincoln, and Central Nebraska (covering the Hastings, Grand Island and Kearney). Recent studies have confirmed what our volunteers and participants have long known, time spent outdoors is recuperative for many physical and mental injuries.

Our program teaches disabled veterans and current service members (any VA disability 0% or higher with an honorable discharge, or still serving) how to tie flies, cast, build fly rods and catch fish in lakes, streams and rivers across Nebraska. This program is free to participants and includes opportunities to travel to places like the Freedom Ranch for Heroes in Montana to test their knowledge in premium trout waters. Additionally, the Heartlands has regional events including a casting competition in Bennet Springs Missouri and a Carp Fishing Tournament hosted by the Omaha Program at Lake Ogallala.
