# Have You Added a New Range to Your 2024 Membership?

Some of you have added a new range to your 2024 membership (for example, you have been a rifle/pistol member and have now added the trap range to your membership; or vice versa, a trap member, but have added the rifle/pistol ranges to your membership). Before you can have access to the new ranges that you have added, you will need to attend one of our orientation sessions.

With the trap range, new members will also need the *LongRange* trap card. This requires a one-time \$20 deposit on the card as well. We have some orientations scheduled each month so, if you are interested, please contact our office and we can provide you with that information.

# No Longer Trap or Rifle/Pistol Member? Turn in these Cards for a Refund

Some members have decided to drop one of our ranges for the 2024 membership years. If this is you and you have one of our *LongRange* trap card(s) and/or gate access card(s), please return these cards and we will refund you the \$20 deposit for each card that you paid when receiving it. You can mail these to us at Lincoln Ikes, 10801 S 134<sup>th</sup> St, Bennet, NE 68317. Once we have received your *LongRange* Trap Card and/or gate access card(s), we will contact our treasurer and he will mail you a check for your deposit.

# Weather / Range Conditions Heads-Up

During the winter months, we try to get the parking lot and the roads leading up to Rifle/Pistol Ranges 1, 2 and 3 plowed as soon as possible. However, when we get a lot of snow or precipitation, all the traps and the cemented areas around the rifle and pistol benches/firing lines can be buried in snow and/or ice. With that in mind, we want all our members to be aware of the following, if you plan on shooting out here after inclement weather:

# IF YOU ARE A CURRENT RIFLE/PISTOL MEMBER:

1. You may need to scoop/clear your area first.

2. DO NOT GO OFF ANY TRAILS THAT HAVE NOT ALREADY BEEN PLOWED. We cannot guarantee that someone will be out here to help at certain times.

# IF YOU ARE A CURRENT TRAP MEMBER:

- 1. The area around the traps and the fan may not be cleared.
- 2. The locks will most likely be frozen. You can hold them in your hands for a while to warm them up if needed.
- 3. Make sure you warm up the machines PRIOR to arming and starting to throw the rocks.

4. You will have to clear any snow away from the machine and pump PRIOR to running it. With the wind that brings in snow, sometimes snow can get inside the traps.

We welcome any volunteers who are willing to come clear these areas during these weather conditions. If you are able and interested, please contact the managers.



# 2024 SUMMER TRAP LEAGUE

Teams can submit their rosters by either email or USPS (no team meeting). Sponsor fees can be paid at that time or the first night of league. Please provide me your team's name two weeks prior to the first night of league. The first night of shooting is scheduled to begin on May 9th and the Summer League is schedule to end on August 22nd, thus a 15-week season (rain out makeup date on August 29<sup>th</sup> if needed). The Fall League is scheduled to run from September 5th through October 24th, thus a season of 8 weeks. Currently the sponsor fees will remain at \$85 per team for the Summer League and \$40 for the Fall League as well as the cost per round of \$8. Teams that are entirely youth shooters will be charged \$50 and \$25 respectively.

During the Summer Trap League season, shooting typically starts at 6:30 p.m. and ends around 9:00-9:30 p.m. on Thursday nights. The team that shoots at 6:30 p.m. one week will shoot at 7:00 p.m. the next week. Only the team members on the roster are allowed to shoot. Scores the first two weeks of the Summer League along with team's shooting ability in the past will be used to classify. (AAA, AA, A, B, etc.) The first round will be from the 16-yard line and based on the team score, a handicap yardage will be assigned. Teams will be assigned on who they are competing against which will change every week.

One point will be assigned for the 16-yard, handicap and overall scores for a potential total of 3 points. All ties will split the point - giving both teams ½ the point. Team members need to have a minimum of one round of 16-yard targets and one round of handicaps during the first two weeks of qualifications. The Fall League will use the Lewis system to establish points with teams shooting at the same time each week.
