#### Lead Mining Closes Trap Range for a Few Weeks

As part of our conservation efforts, our Lincoln Ikes regularly performs lead mining on our trap range and this is our year to do it. The mining company started mining out here on May 12<sup>th</sup> and should be done within four weeks. They plan on putting in long days, are typically done by 6:00 p.m. and generally take off Sundays and Memorial Day. **Therefore, the trap range will be closed during the day until approximately 6:00 p.m. until further notice.** 

After they leave for the day, the trap range is available to our trap members until 10:00 p.m. If you are interested in certain days, please check the website calendar and we will post when the trap range is open for our members to use. We will notify our trap members as soon as we have more updates and when the mining project is complete.

#### Lincoln Ikes Chapter Leadership Elections

Every year, we have four (4) of our board of directors' positions come up for election or re-election to a three-year term. We have four members that would like to be considered for your vote. The requirements and expectations of our board of directors' members are as follows:

#### QUALIFICATIONS FOR THOSE TO BE ELECTED TO THE BOARD OF DIRECTORS:

- Must be an active advocate and paid current year member
- Must be a current member for at least the last two consecutive years (i.e. Cannot run for board until completing at least two (2) full years as a member.)
- Expected to attend monthly board of directors' meetings, which are generally held the second Tuesday of each month in our clubhouse beginning 7:15 p.m.

#### QUALITIES TO LOOK FOR IN A BOARD OF DIRECTOR MEMBER:

- A current member who is an active and vibrant participant of our Lincoln Izaak Walton League and with the values our organization holds
- Someone with a sense of vision to help with the betterment of our Lincoln Ikes as a whole
- Someone with creativity and energy, and willing to give of their talents for our Lincoln Ikes
- A willingness to listen to other member's viewpoints, collaborate and compromise
- The ability and the desire to work with other Board members and current members as a team for the progress of our Lincoln Ikes, keeping safety as the upmost priority

#### OTHER BOARD OF DIRECTORS INFORMATION

- The property, affairs, activities, and concerns of the Lincoln Chapter shall be vested in a Board of Directors consisting of thirteen (13) Directors.
- The new members of the Board shall assume the performance of their duties, on September 1<sup>st</sup> of each year, and shall continue in office until their successors shall be duly elected and qualified.
- New members shall, however, attend the August Board meeting to adequately provide for a smooth transition, and to vote for the newly elected officers for the following year.
- New members elected in July of each year may vote only for new officers during the August board meeting.
- Outgoing members of the board shall retain full voting rights until September 1<sup>st</sup> except for voting on new officers.
- Special meetings of the board of directors may be called by, or at the request of, the president or any two directors.
- <u>Items that are covered during the monthly meetings: Guest Introductions/Presentations, approval of previous meeting's</u> minutes from the secretary, Treasurer's Report, Membership Report, Manager's Reports, Groundskeeper Reports, <u>Committee Reports (Rifle/Pistol Committee Meeting, Archery Committee, Safety & Rules Committee, and Trap</u> <u>Committee), Match Directors Reports, New Business, and Unfinished/Tabled Business.</u>

Current members can email or send their ballots (see in this month's edition) by mail, or wait and hand them in when attending the annual all-members meeting and dinner in the Lincoln Ikes clubhouse on Tuesday, July 29<sup>th</sup> at 6:00 p.m. (ONE BALLOT PER CURRENT REGULAR, STUDENT AND LIFE MEMBER; TWO BALLOTS FOR FAMILY MEMBERSHIPS.) But, before you submit your ballot and decide on your vote, be sure to review the essays each of the candidates have sent in. It is important to know more about who our leaders are and what experiences and skills they bring to the jobs they do for Lincoln Ikes. We thank all of those that have served, are running for re-election and any new candidates! Please see the June and July newsletters for the ballots and cast your vote then.

#### Voting Information

#### 2. Paper Ballot by Mail

#### 3. Paper Ballot in Person

Members who wish to attend the Annual Meeting, which we strongly encourage, can cast their ballot in person. The election committee will be the only people that will view your ballot. The election committee will check all ballots against the current membership roster.

Your vote will remain secret.

The election committee will only use it to check against the current membership roster to make sure that you only vote once. After the election results have been approved, all ballots will be destroyed and all emails deleted.

#### Wildflowers of Lincoln Ikes: Wild Strawberries

Last month we featured wild plums—this month we have wild strawberries. They bloom in May and June and produce fruit in mid-summer. They only grow a few inches above ground, so they make a great ground cover. Their blossoms are about 3/4 inches across and found in clusters of 3 to 5 per plant. This is a hearty plant you can find over much of North America.

#### AN IMPORTANT REMINDER

For those members using the rifle / pistol ranges, especially range 3 (pistol).

The official Izaak Walton Rifle / Pistol Range Rules (revised November 2023) found at our website; page 9 clearly states the following:

"No shot shells are allowed on the pistol range including those fired from a revolver, single shot pistol or other handgun!"

There is a Tactical Shotgun Patterning Station located on the south end of range 1 for use for pistols with the ability to fire shotshells.

Also not allowed on the pistol range are any shoulder fired rifles or carbines firing pistol caliber such as 9mm or .45 ACP.

The bottom of page 10 of the rule book reads:

"Only .17 and .22 S., L., and L.R. and 5 mm rimfire rifles and air rifles are allowed."



These rules exist for your and your fellow shooters safety and to help minimize the damage done to our ranges. Please re-read the current rule book no matter what you shoot or which ranges you use.

The game is quite simple. There are targets cut in the shape of four animals of progressive size set at four distances. For the .22 and field pistol the Chickens are at 25 meters, pigs at 50, turkeys at 75 and rams at 100. In the big bore classes the chickens are at 50 meters the pigs at 100 meters, turkeys at 150 meters and the rams at 200 meters. There are banks of five animals at each firing point, which are shot through twice each for a total 40 round course of fire. There is a thirty second loading period followed by a two-minute firing time for each bank of five targets. After shooting through each set of animals twice, you move to the firing point for the next animal. The average course of fire takes about 30 to 40 minutes.

We shoot three disciplines here at the lkes, big bore, small bore (.22) and field pistol (center fire, straight walled cases no longer than 1.290"). Within these disciplines there are enough categories to accommodate almost any handgun you may own, either with or without a scope.

It is set up so that you can shoot several guns per match if you want. Your first score determines your class so you are only shooting against shooters of like ability.


