### 2023 Membership Renewals & Gate Card Activation

Our 2023 membership renewal notices were mailed out in October. Thank you to all who have already renewed your memberships. For those of you who still need to renew, you have a couple options:

- mail in your renewal application and payment,
- renew your 2023 membership online by going to our website at www.lincolnikes.com, then click "Member Login", which is on the green ribbon just underneath the large photo up top,
- come in during our weekly office hours (see the calendar on the website at www.lincolnikes.com under "News and Events")
- call our office during the regular work week, Monday thru Friday, from 8:00 a.m. –
   5:00 p.m.

If you have not renewed by early January, your gate card has been deactivated. Reactivation of your gate card may take up to a week. Your 2023 range cards are mailed out after we process your renewal applications and payments. If you have any questions regarding your renewal, please contact Natalie or Wes. Thank you!

Please note that the membership dues for 2023 are as follows for REGULAR members (family, student, and life members, please see your renewal notices for your membership dues total or call our office for these different amounts): \$160 for rifle & pistol range access, \$160 for trap range access, or \$200 for all ranges (rifle/pistol and trap). As always, our memberships run for the full 2023 calendar year (January 1st - December 31st), starting when you renew.

## Do you have family/friends interested in becoming a Lincoln Ikes member?

Our New Member Orientations start in our clubhouse and then we go out to each of the ranges to go over our rules, show you what we have to offer and answer any questions that you might have. ### Weather / Range Conditions Heads-Up

During the winter months, we try to get the parking lot and the roads leading up to Rifle/Pistol Ranges 1, 2 and 3 plowed as soon as possible. However, when we get a lot of snow or precipitation, all of the traps and the cemented areas around the rifle and pistol benches/firing lines can be buried in snow and/or ice. With that in mind, we want all of our members to be aware of the following, if you plan on shooting out here after inclement weather:

### IF YOU ARE A CURRENT RIFLE/PISTOL MEMBER:

- 1. You may need to scoop/clear your area first.
- 2. DO NOT GO OFF ANY TRAILS THAT HAVE NOT ALREADY BEEN PLOWED. We cannot guarantee that someone will be out here to help at certain times.

#### IF YOU ARE A CURRENT TRAP MEMBER:

- 1. The area around the traps and the fan may not be cleared.
- 2. The locks will most likely be frozen. You can hold them in your hands for a while to warm them up if needed.
- 3. Make sure you warm up the machines PRIOR to arming and starting to throw the rocks.
- 4. You will have to clear any snow away from the machine and pump PRIOR to running it.

With the wind that brings in snow, sometimes snow can get inside the traps. We welcome any volunteers who are willing to come clear these areas during these weather conditions. If you are able and interested, please contact the managers.

### **Trap Range Rules**

Just a reminder to members that use the Lincoln Ikes trap range on the what shot size is legal to be used on the trap range. The rule is in place to provide safety down range since the larger the size of the pellets the further they can travel. This issue came up recently when I found several illegal shotgun shells in the trash barrels on Range 2. They were  $2^{-3}$ /4 Winchester  $1^{-1}$ /4 oz. 5 shot and 3" Federal Black Cloud 1 1/4 oz BB 1450 fps. Hopefully, someone was just emptying their shell bag into the barrels and not shooting them on the trap range. Remember, only use shot size of  $7^{-1}$ /2,  $8^{-1}$  or  $9^{-1}$  on the trap ranges. This will help keep the ranges safer and also save your shoulder.

When I'm at the range, it is easy to take for granted the clean shooting areas, protective berms and overhead baffles, shooting platforms and stools, target backer boards, graded parking areas, and available bathroom facilities. They are simply part of what is delivered by Lincoln Ikes. However, the shooting areas don't clean themselves. The trash cans don't empty themselves. The roads don't grade themselves. Volunteers help keep everything looking great. This is where we (Ikes members) can make a difference.

Earlier this year my grandson and I participated in a volunteer event to make new backer boards for the shooting ranges. It wasn't difficult work and we had a great crew of members helping with every step in the production process. On our next trip to the range my grandson could make the connection between his time assembling the backer boards and the boards holding his targets while we were shooting. It was a wonderful lesson. 
