The sandblasting was done by Veteran Dustless Blasting and the painting by All Around Painting. Both Fred and Jason were great to work with and did an excellent job.

You may have noticed that most of the baffles had previously been impacted in various locations. With a fresh coat of paint, we will now be able to tell if there are any areas of concern and then can rectify any incidents.

The old orange paint has been replaced with NRA approved nonreflective "Buff" colored paint.

2024 Hunter Sight-In Days

We will be hosting our annual Hunter Sight-In Days, which are open to the public. These will be held on Sundays, November 3^{rd} and 10^{th} . The hours for this annual community event are 9:00 a.m. -3:00 p.m. There are many areas that need to be filled to ensure that we can offer these days for all. Thank you to the many members that have already volunteered! The hours we are needing volunteers for each of these days is approximately 8:00 a.m. until the ranges are cleaned up (about 3:30/4:00 p.m). We would love to have plenty of volunteers so the shifts can be shorter for all.

Here are some of the areas that we need to fill for each day:

- Early morning set-up,
- Gate Information Volunteer,

• Rifle Safety Inspectors (with tools to inspect the firearms prior to use on the range to ensure all screws are tight, and that they have the right ammunition for their firearm),

• Ranges 1, 2 and 4 Sight-In Helpers/Guides, and

• Tear down at the end of the day. Volunteers will need to bring eye and ear protection, rifle rests (if they have any), and spotting scopes or good binoculars.

We are also looking for some great volunteers willing to help feed our busy helpers.

Items we are looking for are:

- Early morning donuts or rolls (this is covered for November 3rd thanks to Tammy Merritt!)
- Soup or easy meals at lunchtime (again, covered November 3rd thanks to Tammy!)
- Cookies or small desserts (and again, covered November 3rd thanks to Tammy!)

Wildflowers of Lincoln Ikes: Crown Vetch

This small lavender and white flower is crown vetch. I found several of these clusters along the road leading to the rifle ranges. It's called "crown" because the blossoms come out in a circle. Notice the buds ready to bloom. Vetch is an old term that means a legume like beans and peas. There are no vegetables that come from this flower—in this instance, "legume" means it fixes nitrogen to the soil, and that's a good thing.


