# **New First Aid Kits**

During the next month or so, new First Aid boxes will be mounted on Rifle/Pistol ranges 1–4, the shelter by the pond and on the fences south of the trap ranges near traps 2, 4 and 6. The bright orange boxes contain 2 distinct containers that are mounted with Velcro to the lid and to the back of the main box.







The container mounted to the lid is a Plano box with an assortment of Band-Aids. It is not necessary to remove the Plano box to retrieve a single Band-Aid.

The shrink-wrapped package attached to the back of the orange box is a Stop the Bleed kit containing a C-A-T tourniquet, QuikClot bleed control dressing and instructions, among other material. This is intended for much more serious injuries.

Please help the Ike's maintain these First Aid Kits by only opening them if you have a need. Hopefully they will never be used.

# **Urgent Message to our Trap Members**

We need your cooperation with a few items out here:

1. The boxes are not being broken down on a regular basis, which is filling up our recycling bin faster than necessary (see photo). Our Lincoln Ikes wants to provide the trap rounds at the lowest rate we can to our trap members; however, if we continue to have this issue, we will have no choice but to increase the trap rounds amount.

Thanks to Craig Manson, we now have box cutters (see photo) in each trap house to help cut the tape and make flattening them easier. Please make sure you are breaking down/flattening ALL of the boxes BEFORE you discard them in the recycling bin by Trap #5.

**2.** We've also found some of the cardboard in the trash barrels on the trap range (second photo). All cardboard needs to be placed in the recycling bin by the rockhouse near Trap #5. Please make sure this is happening so it doesn't add more work to our groundskeeper's/volunteers tasks.

**3.** With the windy weather that we've had, weights need to be put on top of the recycling bin and trash dumpsters too. With the recent wind, we have a lot of trash that has blown out along our south fence line. Our groundskeeper has provided blocks or weights to be put on top of our recycling bin and trash dumpsters to ensure that the lids don't blow open and blow out the trash.

**4.** When you lock up the trap houses when you are done, please make sure that the locks are put on correctly. It makes it harder for the next person to unlock it when the numbers are upside down.

**5.** If you are using the trap scoring chairs, please position the desktop back to the correct position so it is not hanging out unsupported.

Please help us to maintain our Lincoln Ikes and keep the trap round prices as low as we can. If there are areas that you believe we could improve or you are willing to help with, we encourage you to share them with us. Thank you for your cooperation!

# **All Shooters Welcome**

Register in person at the event or just come watch the competition!

- ARA is 22 rimfire benchrest shooting.
- An ARA target consists of 25 record bulls, upon which one shot per bull is shot for score within a maximum of 20 minutes.
- Each target has sighters that you can sight your gun before shooting on the regulation targets. You need to shoot in one sighter to make it official so minimum of 26 per target to as much as you want to shoot at sighters.
- The distance from the forward edge of the bench to the target shall be a minimum of 50 yards.

# \$30 entry fee for 6 targets

Requirements Include:

- Eye & Ear Protection
- Any firearm chambered for .22 Long Rifle cartridge may be used.
- Any rest can be used to shoot on from the bench. One piece rest, separate front and rear rest or sandbags may be used.
- Plan to bring one box of 50 per target and you will have plenty of ammo left over.

#### Details:

We will shoot at 25 meters. Bring a .22 rimfire rifle and some spare mags and gain valuable marksmanship skills without using up your expensive center fire ammo. You will want about 400 - 500 rounds. GI web sling highly recommended. Centerfire is welcome, so if you have a new high-power rifle or new mags you want to test drive at 25-meters, that is OK too. While it is expensive, there is no better way to learn if you can depend on your equipment than putting 400 - 500 rounds through it in.

- No Tracer, AP, or incendiary ammo allowed (fire hazard, hard on steel targets). Attracts a magnet is OK.
- Please leave your rifles in the car until asked to bring them to the firing line.
- Please, no handguns (concealed or open) on the firing line.
- Bring layered clothing, raingear, a windbreaker, and lightweight gloves, eye protection, and hearing
  protection. Dress for the weather and bring raingear if forecasted.
- Bring a lunch, snacks, and plenty of water. A shooting jacket will be extremely helpful, especially if shooting a high-power rifle, and a shooting mat may make prone and sitting positions more comfortably.
- No alcohol permitted.

The game is quite simple. There are targets cut in the shape of four animals of progressive size set at four distances. For the .22 and field pistol the Chickens are at 25 meters, pigs at 50, turkeys at 75 and rams at 100. In the big bore classes the chickens are at 50 meters the pigs at 100 meters, turkeys at 150 meters and the rams at 200 meters. There are banks of five animals at each firing point, which are shot through twice each for a total 40 round course of fire. There is a thirty second loading period followed by a two-minute firing time for each bank of five targets. After shooting through each set of animals twice, you move to the firing point for the next animal. The average course of fire takes about 30 to 40 minutes.

We shoot three disciplines here at the lkes, big bore, small bore (.22) and field pistol (center fire, straight walled cases no longer than 1.290"). Within these disciplines there are enough categories to accommodate almost any handgun you may own, either with or without a scope.

It is set up so that you can shoot several guns per match if you want. Your first score determines your class so you are only shooting against shooters of like ability.
