Lincoln Ikes Chapter Leadership Elections Coming Soon

It is just about time for board elections! Every year, we have four (4) of our board of directors' positions come up for election or re-election to a three-year term. If you or another member you know would like to run, the requirements and expectations of our board of directors' members are as follows:

QUALIFICATIONS FOR THOSE TO BE ELECTED TO THE BOARD OF DIRECTORS:

- Must be an active advocate and paid current year member
- Must be a current member for at least the last two consecutive years (i.e. Cannot run for board until completing at least two (2) full years as a member.)
- Expected to attend monthly board of directors' meetings, which are generally held the second Tuesday of each month in our clubhouse beginning 7:15 p.m.

QUALITIES TO LOOK FOR IN A BOARD OF DIRECTOR MEMBER:

- A current member who is an active and vibrant participant of our Lincoln Izaak Walton League and with the values our
 organization holds
- Someone with a sense of vision to help with the betterment of Lincoln Ikes as a whole
- Someone with creativity and energy who is willing to give of their talents for Lincoln Ikes
- Someone with a willingness to listen to other member's viewpoints, collaborate and compromise
- Someone with the ability and desire to work with other Board members and current members as a team for the progress of Lincoln Ikes, while keeping safety as the upmost priority

OTHER BOARD OF DIRECTORS INFORMATION

- The property, affairs, activities, and concerns of the Lincoln Chapter shall be vested in a Board of Directors consisting of thirteen (13) Directors.
- The new members of the Board shall assume the performance of their duties, on September 1st of each year, and shall continue in office until their successors shall be duly elected and qualified.
- New members shall, however, attend the August Board meeting to adequately provide for a smooth transition, and to vote for the newly elected officers for the following year.
- New members elected in July of each year may vote only for new officers during the August board meeting.
- Outgoing members of the board shall retain full voting rights until September 1st except for voting on new officers.
- Special meetings of the board of directors may be called by, or at the request of, the president or any two directors.
- Items that are covered during the monthly meetings: Guest Introductions/Presentations, approval of previous meeting's minutes from the secretary, Treasurer's Report, Membership Report, Manager's Reports, Groundskeeper Reports, Committee Reports (Rifle/Pistol Committee Meeting, Archery Committee, Safety & Rules Committee, and Trap Committee), Match Directors Reports, New Business, and Unfinished/Tabled Business.

If you would like to run as a nomination for this year's election, please submit a small essay about yourself and why you would like to be considered for our board. These articles will be published in the June and July newsletter along with the ballots. To be included in these newsletters and ballots, please submit your nomination by <u>May 20, 2024</u> to <u>ikes.lincoln@gmail.com</u>.

Current members can email or send their ballots by mail, or wait and hand them in when attending the annual all-members meeting and dinner in the Lincoln Ikes clubhouse on Saturday, July 20th at 12:00 noon. (ONE BALLOT PER REGULAR, STUDENT AND LIFE MEMBER; TWO BALLOTS FOR FAMILY MEMBERSHIPS.) But, before you submit your ballot and decide on your vote, be sure to review the essays each of the candidates have sent in. It is important to know more about who our leaders are and what experiences and skills they bring to the jobs they do for Lincoln Ikes. We thank all of those that have served, are running for re-election and any new candidates! Please see the June and July newsletter for the ballots and cast your vote then.

Match scoring is as follows:

- Depending on number of shooters, initial pairs of shooters will be paired up by random drawing or by shooting a timed qualifying match and individuals will be paired up by their time.
- If qualifying match is shot, shooter will choose what class they shoot and that time will be used
 if the shooter is shooting in other classes.
- · Once pairs are determined, the matches will be shot using a double elimination bracket.

There will be 7 classes as follows:

- 22LR pistol and revolver, pin shoot and pin head shoot
- Medium caliber pistol and revolver, pin shoot, caliber range examples are 380, 9mm, 38 special
- Larger caliber pistol and revolver, pin shoot, caliber range examples are 357 magnum, 40 S&W, 10mm, 45, 44 magnum, no caliber more powerful than a 44 magnum will be allowed, due to damage to pins

IHMSA (International Handgun Metallic Silhouette Association) Matches

2024 Dates (weather permitting):

April 21st, May 19th, June 16th, July 14th, September 22nd, October 20th

Setup starts at 8:00 a.m. with the required safety briefing at 8:30 a.m. The match will be complete by 4:00 p.m.

All Shooters Welcome

\$10 entry fee per shooter (additional guns are \$2 each)
Register in person at the event or just come watch the competition!

The game is quite simple. There are targets cut in the shape of four animals of progressive size set at four distances. For the .22 and field pistol the Chickens are at 25 meters, pigs at 50, turkeys at 75 and rams at 100. In the big bore classes the chickens are at 50 meters the pigs at 100 meters, turkeys at 150 meters and the rams at 200 meters. There are banks of five animals at each firing point, which are shot through twice each for a total 40 round course of fire. There is a thirty second loading period followed by a two-minute firing time for each bank of five targets. After shooting through each set of animals twice, you move to the firing point for the next animal. The average course of fire takes about 30 to 40 minutes.

We shoot three disciplines here at the lkes, big bore, small bore (.22) and field pistol (center fire, straight walled cases no longer than 1.290"). Within these disciplines there are enough categories to accommodate almost any handgun you may own, either with or without a scope.

It is set up so that you can shoot several guns per match if you want. Your first score determines your class so you are only shooting against shooters of like ability.

The match is a 60 round bullseye match with both slow and rapid-fire stages in three positions (prone, seated or kneeling at the shooters choice, and standing). Prone and seated or kneeling stages are fired from 50 yards; standing is fired from 25 yards.

\$10 entry fee per participant

- Eye & Ear Protection
- Rifle chambered in .22LR with a minimum magazine capacity of 5 rounds & 7.5 pound maximum weight
- · 60 Rounds of 22LR for score plus whatever you need for sighting in

2024 Dates (weather permitting)

May 19th, June 16th, July 21st, August 18th, September 15th

Participants need to sign up by 8:30 a.m.;

Match starts at 9:00 a.m. and is generally done by 3:00 p.m.

All Shooters Welcome

Register in person at the event or just come watch the competition!

- ARA is 22 rimfire benchrest shooting.
- An ARA target consists of 25 record bulls, upon which one shot per bull is shot for score within a maximum of 20 minutes.
- Each target has sighters that you can sight your gun before shooting on the regulation targets. You need to shoot in one sighter to make it official so minimum of 26 per target to as much as you want to shoot at sighters.
- The distance from the forward edge of the bench to the target shall be a minimum of 50 yards.

\$30 entry fee per participant for 6 targets

Requirements Include:

- Eye & Ear Protection
- · Any firearm chambered for .22 Long Rifle cartridge may be used.
- Any rest can be used to shoot on from the bench. One piece rest, separate front and rear rest or sandbags may be used.
- · Plan to bring one box of 50 per target and you will have plenty of ammo left over.

SEASON INFORMATION:

Competition will consist of one round of 16-yard and one round of handicap from a pre-determined yard-line.

This year, the youth trap league will run for 8 weeks as follows:

Week 1	(May 20)	25 from the 16-yard line, 25 from the 18-yard line
Week 2	(June 3)	25 from the 16-yard line, 25 from the 18-yard line
Week 3	(June 10)	25 from the 16-yard line, 25 from the 18-yard line
Week 4	(June 17)	25 from the 16-yard line, 25 from the 20-yard line

June 17th is our "Family Fun Night" when any family member may shoot the last 13 of the 25 rocks at 16 yards for a combined family score. This is not required but encouraged. If a family member does participate, a bonus of 3 rocks will be added to the combined score of the youth shooter and the family member's 16-yard score.

Week 5	(June 24)	25 from the 16-yard line, 25 from the 20-yard line
Week 6	(July 1)	25 from the 16-yard line, 25 from the 20-yard line
Week 7	(July 8)	25 from the 16-yard line, 25 from the 23-yard line
Week 8	(July 15)	25 from the 16-yard line, 25 from the 23-yard line

If you miss a week, handicaps will be shot from the yard line scheduled for the current week. For example, if you miss Week 3 and come back to shoot on Week 4, you will shoot all of your handicaps from that day's yard-line which would be 20-yard line. You will need to make up the missed week(s) by Week 7 – no exceptions.

SHOOTING DATES: Monday Evenings; May 20, June 3, 10, 17, 24 and July 1, 8 and 15

SHOOTING TIME: 6:00 pm - 8:00 pm

COST: \$96 for the season

(2 rounds of 25 targets per night: 8 nights x \$12 per night = \$96)
