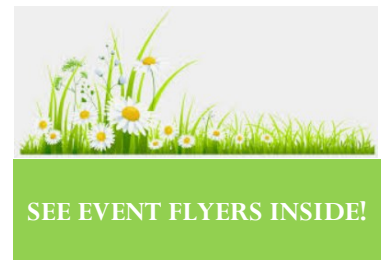

Membership Assistant position

This Chapter is a volunteer-based group Chartered by the Izaak Walton League of America and is accountable to this National organization. The chapter is required to report to the National on the activities of the Chapter and memberships in the Chapter, also being required to provide the State and National with individual members' dues on an annual basis.

The need for this position is to assist in tracking the receipt of new memberships, track current members and supervise the annual process for renewal of membership.

The position will assist with the collection of funds to provide membership dues for the Lincoln Chapter, State Chapter and National organization. and fees charged members for use of the facilities and operation of the Chapter.

Duties and responsibilities

- Coordinate the receipt of original application from prospective members and renewal application from current members. Supervise and coordinate the annual membership renewal process.
- Insuring membership records accuracy and collection of the appropriate dues and fees from each member. Records are highly confidential and are both hard copy and electronically generated containing identifying information.
- Transfer the information contained in the applications to databases, both hard copy and electric, by supervising a filing system on site and using software to store data electronically. Compile statistical information on membership and report this to the Board of directors as required.
- Issue and update individual memberships physical cards and passes for use of the facility, including but not limited to: membership cards, electronic gate keys, cards authorizing use of rifle and pistol ranges, authorizing use of the shotgun traps and the cards needed to operate the electronic target accounting system used for the trap range for payment of targets thrown by each member.
- Retrieving from the Chapter records on membership needed information and transferring same electronically to the State and National This will include data of a confidential nature on members.
- Transfer funds collected from members for dues and facility use to the Chapter Treasurer. Assisting the Treasurer by providing information needed for the accounting and transfer of funds from the Chapter to the State and National organizations covering members' dues.

Estimate of manpower need:

Need varies but we will guarantee the following - February through October will ensure a minimum of two days (16 hours) are paid for per month if necessary. November through January ensure a minimum of two weeks (80 Hours) are paid for per month if necessary.

Know Your Basic Range Commands

When shooting on the Lincoln Ike's rifle or pistol ranges, it is important that members communicate with each other.

This communication includes basic range safety commands that are universal and supported through the NRA.

These include:

“Cease Fire!”

- This command is utilized to denote to all range participants that shooting is to cease immediately. This can be called loud and aggressively by anyone on the range should something seem out of place or unsafe.
- This can also be used as a statement when closing the range down to make sure everyone is aware that shooting is to stop until further commands are given
- Upon hearing this command – all shooters should stop shooting and immediately lay their firearms on the bench to await further commands.

“Range is Closed (or Cold)”

- This is the command to denote that the business of shooting on the range is to stop, firearms unloaded, actions opened and removed from the bench.
- This command allows users to safely go down range to check targets (never allow anyone to go down range until all firearms are made safe).



“Range is Open (or Hot)”

- This command denotes an active range that is now open for use. This means users may bring firearms to the shooting line/bench to load and fire.
- Under more controlled events, this command could be followed by the “Load” and then “Fire at Will” commands

So....a typical range session may sound like this...

1. “If we can have a Cease Fire I would like to close the range to check targets.” Once all firing stops, you would follow up with the “Range Is Closed” command.
2. Once all firearms are safe, users may check targets.
3. Once everyone is safely back behind the shooting line and in agreement to begin shooting, it would be appropriate to give the “Range is Hot or Open” command. Remember, all shooters are wearing hearing protection, so make sure you give commands loud and proud.

There are several more commands but these three are the basics by which all users of the range should communicate with each other to keep the range operating safely. If anyone appears to be violating these commands, it is everyone's duty to address them politely and make sure they hear and understand the need for compliance. **Communication is key!**

Match scoring is as follows:

- Depending on number of shooters, initial pairs of shooters will be paired up by random drawing or by shooting a timed qualifying match and individuals will be paired up by their time.
- If qualifying match is shot, shooter will choose what class they shoot and that time will be used if the shooter is shooting in other classes.
- Once pairs are determined, the matches will be shot using a double elimination bracket.

There will be 7 classes as follows:

- 22LR pistol and revolver, pin shoot and pin head shoot
- Medium caliber pistol and revolver, pin shoot, caliber range examples are 380, 9mm, 38 special
- Larger caliber pistol and revolver, pin shoot, caliber range examples are 357 magnum, 40 S&W, 10mm, 45, 44 magnum, no caliber more powerful than a 44 magnum will be allowed, due to damage to pins

Lincoln Izaak Walton League American Rimfire Association (ARA) Matches 2026 Dates (weather permitting)

May 17th, June 21st, July 19th, August 16th, September 20th

Participants need to sign up by 8:30 a.m.;
Match starts at 9:00 a.m. and is generally done by 3:00 p.m.

**All shooters welcome, however we are limited to a maximum of 20
shooters per day for this event.**

Register in person at the event or just come watch the competition!

- ARA is 22 rimfire benchrest shooting.
- An ARA target consists of 25 record bulls, upon which one shot per bull is shot for score within a maximum of 20 minutes.
- Each target has sighters that you can sight your gun before shooting on the regulation targets. You need to shoot in one sighter to make it official so minimum of 26 per target to as much as you want to shoot at sighters.
- The distance from the forward edge of the bench to the target shall be a minimum of 50 yards.

\$30 entry fee for 6 targets

Requirements Include:

- Eye & Ear Protection
- Any firearm chambered for .22 Long Rifle cartridge may be used.
- Any rest can be used to shoot on from the bench. One piece rest, separate front and rear rest or sandbags may be used.
- Plan to bring one box of 50 per target and you will have plenty of ammo left over.

Optional Items:

- Spotting Scope, Sunscreen, Bug Spray, Drinking Water

The game is quite simple. There are targets cut in the shape of four animals of progressive size set at four distances. For the .22 and field pistol the Chickens are at 25 meters, pigs at 50, turkeys at 75 and rams at 100. In the big bore classes the chickens are at 50 meters the pigs at 100 meters, turkeys at 150 meters and the rams at 200 meters. There are banks of five animals at each firing point, which are shot through twice each for a total 40 round course of fire. There is a thirty second loading period followed by a two-minute firing time for each bank of five targets. After shooting through each set of animals twice, you move to the firing point for the next animal. The average course of fire takes about 30 to 40 minutes.

We shoot three disciplines here at the Ikes, big bore, small bore (.22) and field pistol (center fire, straight walled cases no longer than 1.290"). Within these disciplines there are enough categories to accommodate almost any handgun you may own, either with or without a scope.

It is set up so that you can shoot several guns per match if you want. Your first score determines your class so you are only shooting against shooters of like ability.
